



# Alternate Method of Instruction Delta R-V AMI - Plan Informational Sheet

Effective: August 23, 2021

## what is an Alternative Method of Instruction (AMI) School Plan?

In response to the inclement weather and COVID-19, Delta RV School District will use an Alternate Method of Instruction when necessary. This very detailed plan outlines how instruction will be delivered for ALL students during a day when school is not open due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e., snow days, flooding, or sickness). The plan gives teachers the opportunity to refine their on line presence for content delivery and provides hard copy content for those students that may not have access to technology or network resources. The planned result is less loss of instructional time and increased ability to learn new content when school is back in session. AMI days will be used instead of making up missed days on Holidays, Spring Break, or at the end of the school year.

### **Delivery:**

Not all students have computers or Internet, Delta will be providing a device for 1-12 grade students. Both digital and hard-copy content will be available for students prior to AMI School Days or the day after students return to school if they could not get Internet access.

### **Preparation:**

Teachers will prepare a digital lesson and/or a paper copy lesson for each student to complete each AMI day. Almost all subject areas will be covered, with only a few exceptions.

### **When:**

The plan will go into effect for any reason we cancel school.

### **Content:**

Instructions for accessing digital content and hard copy packets will be provided throughout the school year. Content will be relevant to current Missouri learning standards being taught in the classroom. Online content: IXL, Spanish, Mindtap, Knowledge Matters, ICEV, Superkids, Wonders, McGraw Hill, and Renaissance. Delta will also use securly on their chromebooks for content filtering.

### **Communication:**

An Alert Call will be made to all students and staff announcing AMI school days along with a reminder to complete AMI school work. This will be done through REMIND and FACEBOOK.

### **Accountability & Insurance**

Students will be required to complete all tasks assigned during an AMI day. Extended time will be available for those circumstances whereby the work could not be completed due to extenuating circumstances. Attendance will be based on the completion of AMI assignments. Students will need to purchase insurance for their device. Its a 12 month policy and the cost is \$30.00 per student. If you cannot afford this please contact the administration.

### **Availability:**

Teachers are required to maintain a minimum of an on line presence or communication hours from the hours of 10:00 AM-12:00 PM. Teachers will be available through email and can be contacted through Google Classroom platform.
