

DELTA R-V SCHOOLS INTERNET USAGE AGREEMENT

Access to the Internet is an unparalleled opportunity to interact with the world at large. It has the potential to be a tremendous resource for students and teachers at all levels. The use of an assigned account must be in support of educational research and within the objectives and goals of the Delta R-V School District. The use of this information system is a privilege, not a right; the opportunity brings with it a number of responsibilities. In order to use the school network and Internet service available at Delta R-V Schools, you and your parents must read the following information and return a signed Internet agreement, which is attached.

1. The Delta R-V School District receives its Internet access through MORENet, and all users must abide by the regulations of that consortium. The district Internet code is provided primarily for educational purposes under the direction of district staff. Non-educational use may be limited at any time by staff. Because of the potentially large number of individuals who need to use the computer, student access may be limited.
2. Access to the Delta R-V School District network is a privilege that may be revoked by the administrators of the network at any time for abusive or inappropriate conduct. Such conduct includes, but is not limited to, the placing of unlawful information on or through the computer system; downloading files without express permission of the faculty; accessing another person's files or e-mail; the use of obscene, abusive, or otherwise objectionable language or images in either public or private files or messages; and use of chat rooms, USENET newsgroups, My-Space, Face book, (Related Sites) and other areas of cyberspace that would be offensive to any student, teacher, or parent.
3. Rules and regulations of the system usage may be added and will be posted from time to time by the administrators of the district and/or the network. Users of the network are subject to these rules and regulations.
4. Use of obscene, harassing, or abusive language on-line is prohibited. Good manners and good taste are the rule, no matter what environment the student may find him/herself in. Adhere to the same standards on-line that are expected in the classroom. Be ethical. Do not do or say anything that your parents or teachers would not approve of. When in doubt, **ASK**.
5. Security on any computer system is high priority, especially when the system involves many users. Attempts to log in as a system administrator or any other user will result in cancellation of user privileges, as will allowing anyone outside the school environment to have access to the school network. Any user identified as a security risk or having a history of problems with other computer systems may be denied access.
6. Vandalism will result in cancellation of privileges. Vandalism is defined as any malicious attempt to harm or destroy data of another user or any of the agencies of other networks that are connected to the Internet backbone. This includes, but is not limited to, the uploading/downloading of files and/or creation of computer viruses.
7. If you break the rules, you **will** lose your school-sponsored Internet access, you **may** lose all computer access, and other penalties may be assessed.

TECHNOLOGY USAGE

(Employee/Student Technology Agreement)

I have read the Delta R-V School District Technology Usage policy, administrative regulations, and netiquette guidelines and agree to abide by their provisions. I understand that violation of these provisions may result in disciplinary action taken against me including, but not limited to, suspension or revocation of my access to district technology and termination.

I understand that my technology usage is not private and that the school district may monitor my use of district technology including, but not limited to, accessing browser logs, e-mail logs, and any other history of use. I consent to district interception of or access to all communications I send, receive, or store using the district's technology resources, pursuant to state and federal law, even if the district's technology resources are accessed remotely.

I understand I am responsible for any unauthorized costs arising from my use of the district's technology resources. I understand that I am responsible for any damages to district technology due to my negligent or intentional misuse of the district's technology resources.
